Please check the letter from Session about scheduling that has been sent to the Prayer Chain e-mail list. It will also be attached to this bulletin.



# SCRIPTURE LESSONS: Deuteronomy 18:15 - 20

15 "The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers — it is to him you shall listen — <sup>16</sup> just as you desired of the LORD your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, 'Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.' <sup>17</sup> And the LORD said to me, 'They are right in what they have spoken. <sup>18</sup> I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. <sup>19</sup> And whoever will not listen to My words that he shall speak in My name, I myself will require it of him. <sup>20</sup> But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.'

### Mark 1:21 - 28

<sup>21</sup> And they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and was teaching. <sup>22</sup> And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one who had authority, and not as the scribes. <sup>23</sup> And immediately there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit. And he cried out, <sup>24</sup>

"What have You to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know Who You are — the Holy One of God." <sup>25</sup> But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be silent, and come out of him!" <sup>26</sup> And the unclean spirit, convulsing him and crying out with a loud voice, came out of him. <sup>27</sup> And they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him." <sup>28</sup> And at once His fame spread everywhere throughout all the surrounding region of Galilee.
